In Texas, we have a general election, November 7, 2017. Early voting is October 23 - November 3. If your voter registration is not current, you have until October 10, 2017 to get to your County's Election Administrations Office to register, in order to be eligible to vote November 7.

Here is a fairly extensive description of the seven amendments being proposed to the Texas State Constitution, citing both the pros and the cons. It gives the ballot language you'll see on the ballot, it gives a background explanation about why the proposition is an
